



Home learning opportunities:

- Every Friday we shall send out the links to the phonics games via SeeSaw. These links will share the phonemes that we are teaching that week.




- Each week your child will bring home a new rhyme in their 'Rhyme of the Week books'. We want the children to learn the rhyme and to be able to identify rhyming words. We collect these books in on a Wednesday and give them back out on a Friday.






- Your child will receive new reading and phonics sheets in their folders which you can use as a reading and writing opportunity. As we learn the phonemes and common exception words (CEWs), we shall add yellow and green flash cards to a plastic envelope in the back of your child's yellow reading and phonics folder. Please use these to play phonics games, such as; phoneme spotting and word building. We shall do these in batches, so please do keep an eye out for them.

- Your child shall receive a Phonics International book which is matched to our phonics teaching. You shall have this book for 1 – 2 weeks so you can read a page or two a night with them. As you'll notice, there is plenty of text for your child to work on their reading skills and research demonstrates that repetition and consolidation is a key component to becoming a fluent reader.



- Your child will also receive a book which is matched to their phonic knowledge and skills.



- Purple Mash and NumBots are online platforms where you can explore a variety of learning games with your children. You will receive the logins to these platforms in the coming weeks.
