It's World Book Day on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March and we have lots planned!

### Dressing up!

Children are encouraged to dress up as a character from their favourite book. We look forward to seeing their costumes!

### Competition

If you are in YR, we would like you to draw a picture of your favourite book character.

If you are in Y1, we would like you to design a **new** front cover for your favourite book.

If you are in Y2, we would like you to write a short review of a book you have really enjoyed reading. You can tell us why you enjoyed reading this book and what your favourite part or character was. You can also draw a small picture to accompany your book review.

You can use any materials you want to do this, e.g. pencils, paint, collage. It has to be your own work and cannot be traced. Entries should be no larger than a piece of A4. You can use the form overleaf if you so wish. Entries must include your name and class. There is no obligation to enter the competition.

Entries need to be in by **Monday 26<sup>th</sup> February**. The competition will be judged that week and two prizes will be given on World Book Day to each year group.



### Eco 'Bring and Buy' book sale

We are running a book sale on World Book Day. Please could you bring any old, unwanted books to school by **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> February**, either to your child's class teacher or to Reception. Children will then be given the opportunity to visit the book sale and can purchase a book for 50p. Please can children who want to buy a book bring their 50p in on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March. All money raised will be used by the Eco committee to attract more wildlife to our Nature Area.

We will also be running a sponsored 'Readathon' during the week of World Book Day. It will be explained to the children on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> February and letters will go home on this day.
