

## **CKIS School Council – Meeting 4 – 31.01.2018**

GW and 15 children present.

Agenda:

- Feedback from classes about what could be improved in CK and what other things they might like to see in CK – specifically the area around Kings Hall and Grange Field.

Points discussed:

The children thought that they could benefit from:

- Another food shop.
- More flowers and trees to make it look nicer.
- Paintings – they thought these could be outside on the walls and/or on the pathways or inside the Kings Hall in the form of an art gallery. If the paintings were to be outside, the children felt that they should be of natural things or to help them with their 'letters and learning'. They also talked about having some sort of trail painted on the floor that they could follow along the path.
- A park with sections for children of different age groups.
- A swimming pool.
- A pond.
- More bins for litter.
- A dog exercise park where dogs could run and jump.
- A pet shop/stall alongside the dog park.
- A gym area with weights (although I think something similar is already in the field).
- A rally track for bikes.
- More signs to encourage people to keep everywhere tidy.
- Water fountains to play in during the nicer weather – some children suggested a water park.
- One child suggested that the Kings Hall could be used as a school in the holidays.
- They did say that they loved the Christmas fair that happens in the area so they wouldn't want anything that would take up space and therefore prevent the fair from happening.

Actions for next meeting:

- GW to email these minutes to representative on the Parish Council.
- Classes to elect new school council reps for the second half of the academic year.
- Next focus to be how the children at CKIS feel about school – first meeting with new reps will be based around designing a questionnaire to use with each class.
